

# Social Media Press Kit Usage Guide

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Adding event information to the template and uploading to social media

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### **PDF: OPENING THE FILE AND ADDING TEXT**



In the Press Kit folder, open the PDF for feed, story, or email using Adobe Acrobat.

On the right side, select "**Edit PDF**" from the menu.



From the options on the upper bar, select "Add Text".



Click the cursor on the image to add text, and begin typing the relevant information.



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### **PDF: FORMATTING TEXT**



To format, highlight all the text in the text box, and begin making adjustments in the Format panel on the right side of the document.



For most cases, the text shows up best when white. To do this, click on the black box to open the "**Colors**" window. Where it says "**Hex Color #**", type in "**FFFFFF**". Close out the "Colors" window, and the text will be white.





## **PDF: FORMATTING TEXT**



Use a similar text format under both the "When" and "Where" sections for consistency.



Once the text is finalized, press the "**Close**" button in the upper right corner to exit the text editor. Text editing can always be reopened by clicking the "Edit PDF" selection from the side panel on the right of the document.





#### **PDF: EXPORTING AS JPEG**



When the image is complete with the necessary text information, it will have to be exported as a JPEG before it can be uploaded to social media.

To do this, go to the menu at the very top of the screen, and select File>Export To>Image>JPEG.





Name the file and select the location of where the final JPEG will go, then press "Save".



### **INSTAGRAM: STORY POST**



To format the Story post directly in Instagram, download it to your mobile device and begin a **story post**.

In the bottom left, tap the icon to select the image from your **camera roll**.

Tap the "**Aa**" icon in the upper right to begin adding text.





#### **INSTAGRAM: ADDING TEXT**



Begin entering the necessary informative text for the event. Duplicate the same format for both "When" and "Where" sections for consistency.





### **INSTAGRAM: FORMATTING TEXT**



Instagram has many easy to use formatting options for text. These can be helpful for adding emphasis to certain pieces of information.

When complete, tap the "**Your Story**" button on the bottom left to upload the image to your story.





#### **INSTAGRAM: FEED POST**



For feed posts, follow the same process as before to add appropriate text to the image. Once finalized, tap the **download icon** at the top of your screen to save the image to your camera roll.





## **INSTAGRAM: CROPPING ON MOBILE**



To get rid of the extra space instagram adds, tap the "**Edit**" button on the top right of the screen to crop the photo.

Once cropped back to its original aspect ratio, tap "**Done**" to save the changes. Now that it has been cropped, this image may be uploaded to Instagram or Facebook as a feed post.
